Snow Removal Reminder

- ◆ The Right-of-Way is a dedicated strip of land intended for the accommodation of traffic movements, utilities, drainage, and other similar public uses. During the winter season, the right-of-way behind the roadway is reserved for snow storage to expedite snow removal. This area may extend seven feet or more beyond the road edge, into the Lot.



- ◆ Each owner of an adjacent walkway is required to remove the snow from the walkway. Your neighbors and their kids use the walkways for exercise and to get to school, a cleared walkway is safer then walking in the road.
- ◆ All snow from your driveway MUST be deposited on the lot from where it came. It is unlawful to deposit snow on to a public right of way or a neighbors lot. Please help out.

Parking

Inoperative vehicles may not be stored in the driveways. It is suggested that if you have a vehicle that is not used often, make sure you clear it of snow through out the winter so as not to appear to be an inoperative stored vehicle. Although the MOA allows street parking for up to 24hrs, remove vehicles in order for the city to plow the streets.
